- ❖ Snakes cannot bite food so have to **swallow it whole**.

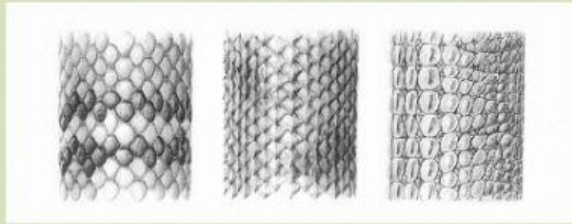


- ❖ Snakes have flexible jaws which allow them to eat pray bigger than their head.
