These two questions are in the **Present Perfect Tense** but what difference can you see? Type your answer!

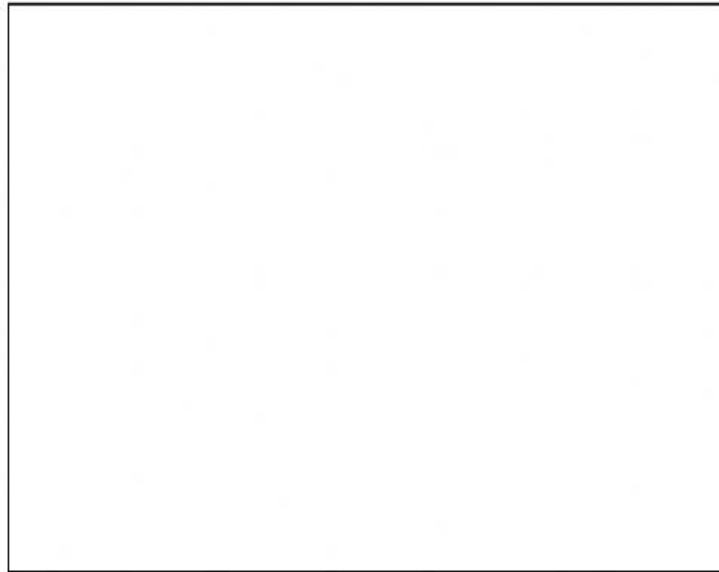
We call this new verb tense
