

# ADVERBS OF MANNER

Adverbs of manner tell u show an action is done. We form adverbs of manner by adding -ly to an adjective.

For example: slow – slowly. The tortoise walks slowly.

## Form adverbs of manner

SLOW	
LOUD	
HAPPY	
ANGRY	
SLEEPY	
NOISY	
QUIET	
QUICK	
EASY	

If the adjective ends with -y replace the -y with an -i and add -ly (lazy – lazily)


