### REMEMBER:

- AFTER + PAST PERFECT
- BEFORE + SIMPLE PAST
- BECAUSE + PAST PERFECT
- WHEN + SIMPLE PAST
- The OLDEST action takes the PAST PERFECT tense (HAD + PAST PARTICIPLE).
