- **Although** можем да поставим в началото на изречението или между двете идеи.
Although *I was late, I didn't get into trouble.*
I didn't get into trouble although I was late.
- След *despite* и *in spite of* винаги следва *-ing* форма на глагола.

Despite having *lots of arguments, they didn't split up.*

- Обикновено, когато противопоставяме идея с отделно изречение, започваме второ изречение с *however* или *on the other hand*.

We went out a few times. However, we were never really in love.

She might say yes. On the other hand, she might not.

Внимание – често допускани грешки!

Despite I am an only child, I'm never lonely. X

*Despite **being** an only child, I'm never lonely. ✓*

***Although** I am an only child, I'm never lonely. ✓*
