



# Present Continuous



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**Let's revise some rules****Positive & Negative**

- The **present continuous** tells about actions happening **right now**

Positive			Negative		
I He/She/It You/We/They	am is are	walking.	I He/She/It You/We/They	am <b>not</b> <b>isn't</b> <b>aren't</b>	walking.

**right now** **She is sleeping now.**

- Spelling rules for the present continuous

Verb Type	Base Form	Present Continuous		Rule
most verbs	go listen	going listening	working staying	+ -ing
verbs ending in -e	come change	coming changing	taking arriving	-e → -ing
verbs ending in a vowel + a consonant	sit begin	sitting beginning	planning stopping	double consonant + -ing
