<p><b>Subject + be going to + verb</b>  <b>I am going to buy</b> a car.  <b>He/she/it is going to buy</b> a car.  <b>You/We/They are going to buy</b> a car.</p>	<p><b>Subject+ be not going to+ verb</b>  <b>I am not going to buy</b> a car.  <b>He/she/it is going to buy</b> a car.  <b>You/We/They are going to buy</b> a car.</p>	<p><b>Be+ subject+ going to+ verb</b>  <b>Am I going to buy</b> a car?  <b>Is he/she/it is going to buy</b> a car?  <b>Are you/we/they going to buy</b> a car?</p>
