4. It was a war in Spain fought from 1936 to 1939. The Nationalists won the war, which ended in early 1939, and ruled Spain until Franco's death in November 1975.

6. It was restored after Franco's death in 1975 and the approval of the Constitution of 1978.
7. Nationalist dictator who ruled Spain from 1939 to 1975.
8. Spain is divided into _____ (for example, Andalucía, Cataluña, Galicia, etc.).
9. It was approved in 1978 and led to the restoration of democracy in Spain.
10. King emeritus of Spain whose reign lasted from 1975, after Franco's death, until 2014, when he abdicated. His son is the current King of Spain.
11. The Autonomous Communities of Spain are divided into _____ (for example, Zaragoza, Segovia, Toledo, etc.).
12. The official name of Spain is the "_____ of Spain".
13. It is one of the three branches of the government and is responsible for governing the state. It is made up of the Prime Minister and the ministers (chosen by the president).
14. It is one of the three branches of the government and is responsible for passing the laws. It is represented by the Cortes Generales and it also appoints the president and controls the government. It is made up of the Cortes Generales (Congreso de los Diputados and Senado).
15. It is one of the three branches of the government and is responsible for making sure that people respect the law; it can declare a law constitutional. It is made up of the Consejo General del Poder Judicial and the Tribunal Supremo.
