A LOOK AT THE UNITED STATES

1 The United States became an independent country on July 4th, 1776. The American capital is Washington D.C. (the letters stand for *District of Columbia*). About 265 million people live in an area of 9,363,130 km². 84% of the American population are white: 12% are black.

5 English, the American main language, has become one of the world's most important form of international communication. Spanish is the second most widely spoken language. Other languages frequently spoken include Chinese, Korean, Portuguese, Japanese, Arabic, etc.

The United States of America has a Federal Republican form of government. The President, who lives in the White House, is elected every four years but can serve two terms (8 years), if re-elected. The American Congress has two houses: The House of Representatives (435 members) 10 and the Senate (100 members).

The U S has a Christian majority: Protestant and Catholic, but a Jewish minority and several smaller religious groups can also be found.
