If you have a **talent** for music, why not think about writing music for movies? Josh Taylor is a movie music writer. He says, "Next month I'm starting work on the music for a horror movie. Good music is very important for horror movies because it gives the movie a scary feeling."

Paula Mendez loves clothes and fashion, and she **designs** costumes for movies. Next week she is starting work on some costumes for a musical. "Musicals are fun, because the costumes are bright and colorful," she says. "But I'd love to be the costume designer for a fantasy movie, so I can really use my **imagination**."

We all love animated movies like *Toy Story*, and that means there are a lot of jobs for animators – the people who **create** these movies. "You **don't** have to be good at drawing to be an animator," says Andy Brown. "I can't draw, but I have good computer skills. These skills are important if you want to work on computer-animated movies."

We don't see the actors in animated movies, but they are still there. Lucinda Taylor is a voice actor. "I love acting, and everybody tells me I have a **perfect** voice for animated characters." You can hear Lucinda's voice in TV commercials and also in some popular computer games. Next month she is starting work on her first animated movie.

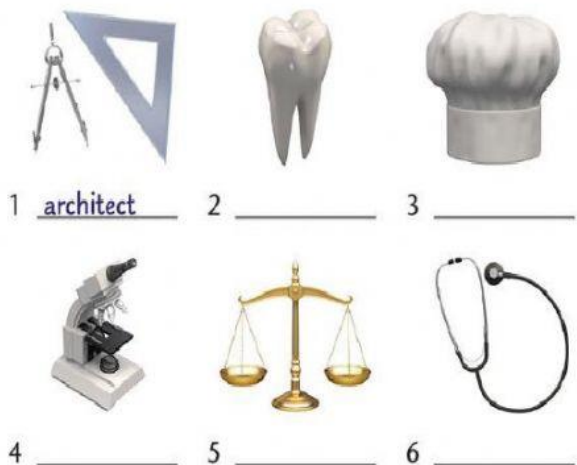
