



## Type 1 Conditional Sentences

(A) Type 1 conditionals are used to talk about something that is always true or always happens.



(B) You can change the order of the two clauses. The meaning is the same. We do not use a comma when the main clause comes first.



● Note : The negative form of **will not = won't**
