1. (a) Match the words to their meaning.

Words	Meaning
Winner	someone who wants a particular team to win and might show it by going to watch the team play
Loser	a number of people or animals who do something together as a group
Champion	a person or team that does not win a game or competition
Tournament	the leader of a sports team
Supporter	a point scored in some sports, such as football and hockey, when a player gets the ball into this area
Team	someone who wins a game, competition, or election
Opponent	a large closed area of land with rows of seats around the sides and often with no roof, used for sports events and musical performances
Captain	a competition for teams or single players in which a series of games is played, and the winners of each game play against each other until only one winner is left
Race	someone whose job is to teach people to improve at a sport, skill, or school subject
Match	a person who someone is competing against in a sports event
Goal	a competition in which all the competitors try to be the fastest and to finish first
Stadium	someone or something, especially a person or animal, that has beaten all other competitors in a competition
Coach	a sports competition or event in which two people or teams compete against each other

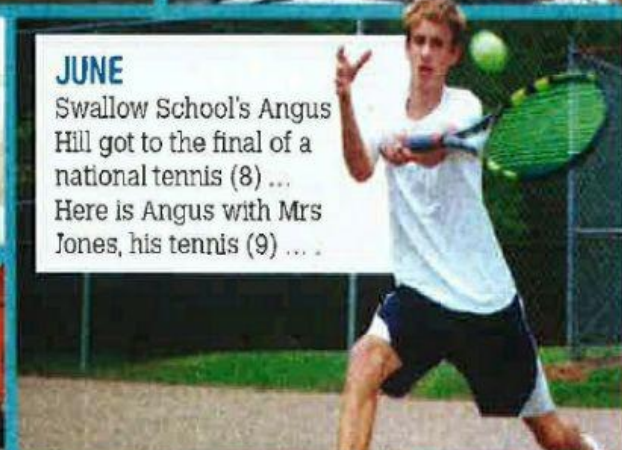


APRIL
