Word Types: conjunction, adverb, pronoun, interjection, verb, noun, adjective, preposition.

Word Type	Definition of Word Type
	A word or phrase that <u>modifies</u> or <u>qualifies</u> an adjective or verb or a word group.
	A word naming an <u>attribute</u> of a noun.
	A word used to describe an <u>action</u> , state, or occurrence, and forming the main part of the predicate of a sentence.
	A word used to identify any of a class of <u>people, places or things</u> or to name a particular one of these.
	A word governing and usually <u>preceding</u> a noun or pronoun and expressing a relation to another word or element in the clause.
	A word that can function as a noun phrase used by itself and that refers either to the <u>participants</u> in the discourse or to <u>someone</u> or <u>something</u> mentioned elsewhere in the discourse.
	A word used to <u>connect</u> clauses or sentences or to coordinate words in the same clause.
	An <u>exclamation</u> , especially as a part of speech.
