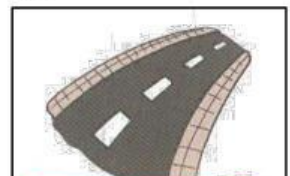

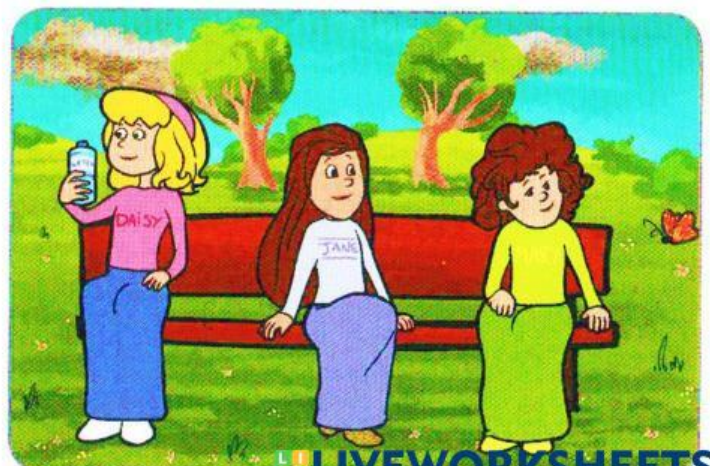
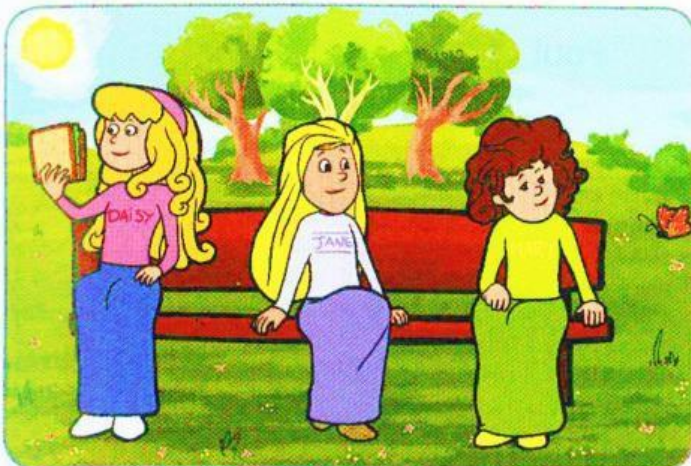


A family trip
