

WEATHER VOCABULARY



it's raining (heavily) / it's pouring (with rain) / it's drizzling.

there is # light rain / there is a drizzle

you get wet / you get s..... (to the bone)

the sun is shining / it's sunny / there is a lot of sunlight (sun)

it's boiling hot / it's sc..... (hot)

the heat is unbe..... / it's so hot (that) you can h..... breathe
= stand the heat

it's murky and st....., there might be a storm in the afternoon

it's foggy / there is d..... (=thick) fog, you can hardly see anything

it's windy / there is a strong wind # a light breeze/ there's a tornado/whirlwind

the wind is so strong it can b..... your hat off

it's cloudy / the cloudless sky (= zero clouds)

it's fr..... cold / the frost has covered the grass / a fro..... morning

it's snowing / the snow is thick / the snowd..... are 2 m high



it's hailing / the h..... was as big as golf balls

it's storming / there's is a terrible (violent) storm



the temperature will d..... below 0 at night

0 degrees Celsius is equal to 32 degrees Fahrenheit:

$$0^{\circ}\text{C} = 32^{\circ}\text{F}$$

it hasn't rained/snowed 3 weeks

it's been rain...../snow..... non-stop for 2 days
