

REPORTED / INDIRECT SPEECH

Present Continuous → Past Continuous

He **said** "I **am working** at the office these days"

He **said** that he **was working** at the office those days.

Now → at that moment

This week → that week

These days → those days

Present Simple → Past Simple

He **told me** "I **work** at the office every day"

He **told me** that he **worked** at the office every day.

Past Simple → Past Perfect

He **told me** "I **worked** with my colleague yesterday"

He **told me** that he **had worked** with his colleague the day before.

Yesterday → the day before

Last week → the previous week
