They fix the plant so it doesn't move or fall.

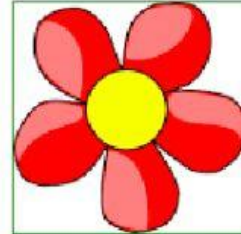
They are usually green. They have many shapes and sizes.
They absorb sunlight to transform the air and the water in food.
They inhale dioxide of carbon and they exhale oxygen.

They are in charge of the reproduction.
Their petals are usually colourful and sometimes smell to attract birds, bees and insects.

They support the plant, so it can stand up straight.
They transport the water and the nutrients around the plant.

They protect the seeds of the plant from birds, insects and diseases.
Humans need to eat them to stay healthy.

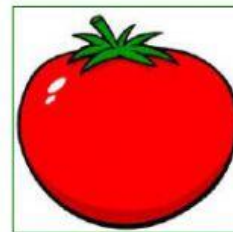
They are little cases that have a baby plant.
