I've swum with dolphins .

- I have never tried skiing .
I've never tried skiing .



? Have you ever swum with dolphins ? Yes , I have .

Have you ever tried skiing ? No , I haven't .

(he / she)

+ She has seen a lion .
She's seen a lion .

- She has never seen a panda .
She's never seen a panda .



? Has she ever seen a lion ? Yes , she has .

Has she ever seen a panda ? No , she hasn't .

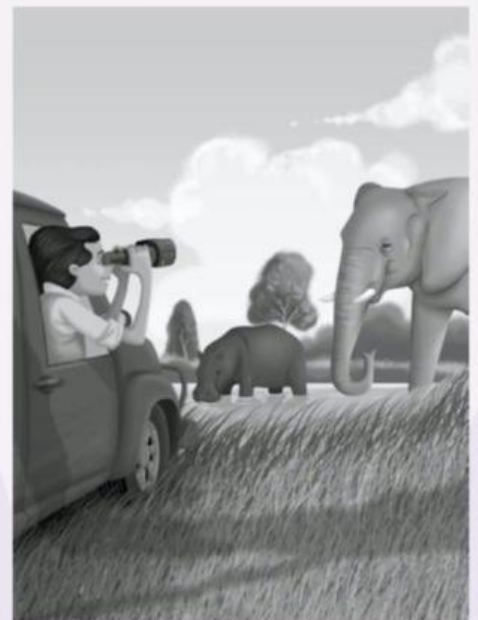
