Usamos have to cuando las oraciones comienzan con I, YOU, WE o THEY.

Por ejemplo:

I ALWAYS HAVE TO MAKE MY BED.

YOU HAVE TO CLEAN YOUR ROOM.

WE HAVE TO WASH OUR HANDS.

THEY USUALLY HAVE TO STUDY FOR A TEST.

Usamos has to cuando las oraciones comienzan con HE, SHE o IT.

Por ejemplo:

HE ALWAYS HAS TO TAKE OUT THE RUBBISH.

SHE SOMETIMES HAS TO DO THE DISHES.
