The giraffe is **taller than** the zebra.

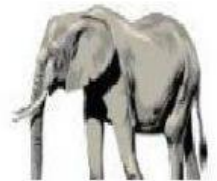


1. The mouse is (small) the horse.

The hare is **madder than** the rabbit.

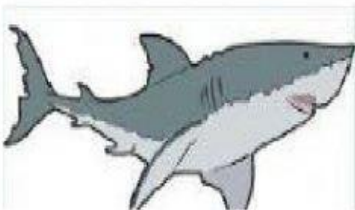
1. The elephant is (big) the rhino.
