COMMUNITY BASED INSTRUCTION

ON MOUNTAIN ROADS:

- 1) WHEN 2 VEHICLES MEET ON A _____ ROAD WHERE NEITHER VEHICLE CAN PASS, THE VEHICLE FACING DOWNHILL MUST YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY BY BACKING UP UNTIL THE VEHICLE GOING UPHILL CAN PASS.
- 2) THE VEHICLE FACING _____ HAS GREATER AMOUNT OF CONTROL WHEN BACKING UP THE HILL.

SPEED LIMITS:

- 1) CALIFORNIA'S "BASIC _____ LAW" MEANS THAT YOU MAY NEVER DRIVE FASTER THAN IS SAFE FOR CURRENT CONDITIONS.
- 2) REGARDLESS OF THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT, YOUR SPEED SHOULD DEPEND ON:
 - A) THE _____ AND SPEED OF OTHER VEHICLES ON THE ROAD.
 - B) WHETHER THE ROAD _____ IS SMOOTH, ROUGH, GRAVELED, WET, DRY, WIDE, OR NARROW.
 - C) BICYCLISTS OR PEDESTRIANS ON OR CROSSING THE ROAD WAY.
 - D) WHETHER IT IS RAINING, FOGGY, _____, WINDY, OR DUSTY.
 - E) UNLESS OTHERWISE POSTED, THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT IS 55 MPH ON A TWO-LANE _____ HIGHWAY AND FOR VEHICLES TOWING TRAILERS.

REDUCED SPEEDS:

HEAVY TRAFFIC OR BAD WEATHER:

- 1) YOU MUST DRIVE _____ WHEN THERE IS HEAVY TRAFFIC OR BAD WEATHER.
- 2) HOWEVER, IF YOU _____ NORMAL AND REASONABLE MOVEMENT OF TRAFFIC BY DRIVING TOO SLOWLY, YOU MAY BE CITED.
- 3) IF YOU CHOOSE TO DRIVE SLOWER THAN OTHER _____, DO NOT DRIVE IN THE "NUMBER 1 LANE" (FAST LANE).
- 4) WHEN ANOTHER DRIVER IS CLOSE BEHIND YOU AND WISHES TO DRIVE FASTER, YOU SHOULD MOVE TO THE _____.
