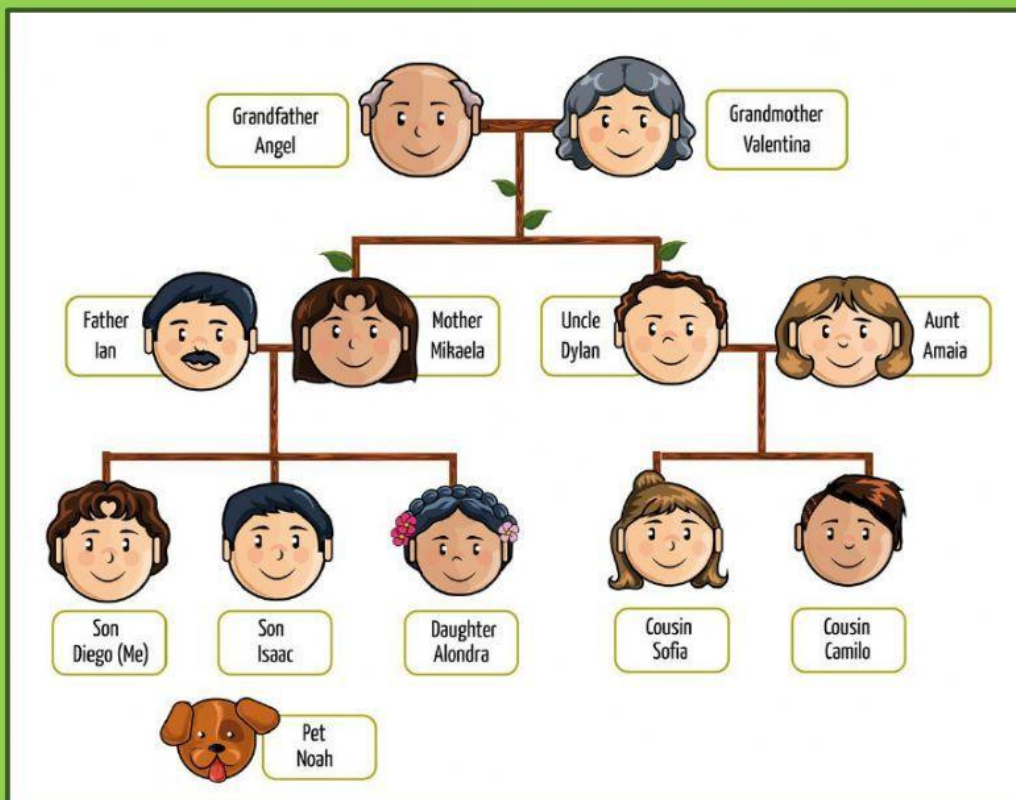


# HAVE GOT OR HAS GOT
