



## Pronouns and Point of View

### Grade 5 Pronouns Worksheet

Point of View refers to who is telling or narrating a story. A story can be told in three different ways – 1<sup>st</sup> person, 2<sup>nd</sup> person, and 3<sup>rd</sup> person.

<b>1<sup>st</sup> Person:</b> I, me, we <b>2<sup>nd</sup> Person:</b> your, you, yours <b>3<sup>rd</sup> Person:</b> he, she, it, they, or a name
