

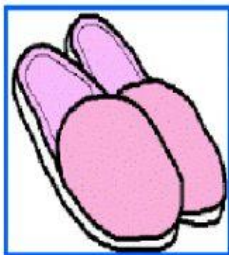
Connectors: and, but, because and so



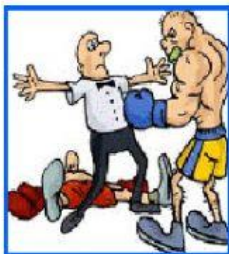

But

But expresses contrast. When we use it we are opposing two ideas.

Because

Because expresses cause. When we use it we are presenting a reason.

So

So expresses the result of something stated on the previous sentence.
