

THE USE OF "OTHER"

OTHER / OTHERS: Other, *Başka, diğer* anlamını verir. Kendisinden sonra **çoğul isim** alır ve **genel** şeylerden bahsederken kullanılır. OTHERS ise *başkaları, diğerleri* anlamını verir ve kendisinden sonra **isim almaz**, zamir olarak kullanılır.

ÖRNEK: While some people prefer drinking coffee in the morning, other people like a cup of tea.

While some people prefer drinking coffee in the morning, others like a cup of tea.

THE OTHER/THE OTHERS: **The other**, diğeri, öteki anlamını verir. Daha önce bahsedilen grup içinde geri kalanları ifade eder. **Tekil ve çoğul** isimlerle kullanılabilirdiği gibi **tek başına** da kullanımı mümkündür. **The others** ise zamir olarak kullanılır ve çoğul ismin yerini tutar.

ÖRNEK: The majority of my students passed the exams. The other ones failed.

Some of the guests left the party early. The others had fun all night.
