NEGATIVE FORM

Sbj + am/is/are + NOT + Ving

I	+	am not	+	start ^{ing}

She	+	is not	+	start ^{ing}
It		isn't	+	start ^{ing}

We				
You	+	are not	+	start ^{ing}
They		aren't	+	start ^{ing}



Ex She is not (isn't) crying.
