Saturn is the sixth planet from the sun in our solar system. The average temperature on Saturn is -300°F , so it is extremely cold there. Saturn spins fast so one day on Saturn is about 10 Earth hours long, but one year is 10,759 Earth days. Saturn is an outer planet and is a gas giant. It is known for its beautiful rings that are 170,000 miles across. Saturn is not the only planet with rings, though. Jupiter, Uranus and Neptune also have rings. There are 53 official moons orbiting Saturn.
