Present perfect simple - *have / has + past participle*

Affirmative

We've (have) **been** to Italy.
He's (has) **changed** school three times.

Negative

We **haven't** (have not) **been** to Italy.
He **hasn't** (has not) **changed** school three times.

Questions

Have you **been** to Italy?
Yes, we **have**. / No, we **haven't**.
Has he **changed** school three times?
Yes, he **has**. / No, he **hasn't**.
Where **have** you **been**?
How many times **has** he **changed** school?
