I. Listening

Content aim:

Students will be able to identify at least 5 words related to labor and employment practice in outsourcing practice that is able to use in Colombia.

Language aim:

Students will be able to identify sentences in present, past and present and past perfect tense.

II. Moments of Listening

II.1. PRE- Listening.

We're going to use the tool Padlet to remember the final outcome of the subject (Make a video for a business man when you give a legal advice about the best way to hire videogame testers), and receiving the previous ideas that students are preparing by the video.

In Padlet the students must answer the next questions:

Students will have 10 minutes to write a summary of the answer and 5 minutes for each group to present the answer to the questions.

II.2. While Listening.
