Let's do this together

a) $4 \times 2 = 8$

$2 \times \square = 8$

$8 \div 2 = 4$

$8 \div 4 = \square$

$4 \times 2 = \square$

$2 \times 4 = \square$

These are related multiplication facts.



b) $\square \times 4 = 28$

$4 \times \square = 28$

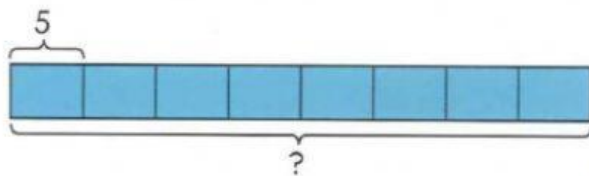
$28 \div 4 = \square$

c) $\square \times 10 = 40$

$10 \times \square = 40$

$40 \div 10 = \square$

There are 5 stickers on each card.
How many stickers are there on 8 cards?



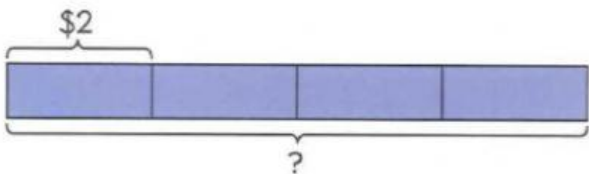
Multiply 8 by 5.

$8 \times 5 = \square$

There are $\square$ stickers altogether.



David bought 4 pineapples at \$2 each.
How much did he pay altogether?



$4 \times \$2 = \$\square$

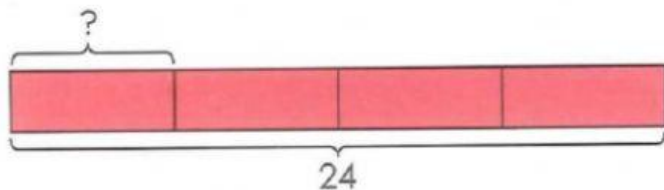
He paid \$ $\square$ altogether.

Multiply 4 by 2.



You try...

Sumin arranged 24 toy soldiers in 4 rows.
There were an equal number of toy soldiers in each row.
How many toy soldiers were there in each row?



$$24 \div 4 = \square$$

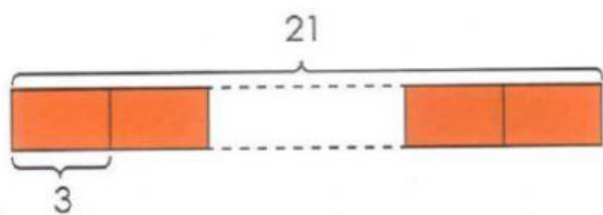
There were $\square$ toy soldiers in each row.

$$4 \times \square = 24$$

$$24 \div 4 = \square$$



A tailor used 21 m of cloth to make dresses.
She used 3 m of cloth for each dress.
How many dresses did she make?



$$21 \div 3 = \square$$

She made $\square$ dresses.

$$3 \times \square = 21$$

$$21 \div 3 = \square$$
