

Punctuating Sentences with Conjunctions

Conjunctions are words that are used to combine two sentences. Whenever you add a conjunction in the middle of the two sentence, add a comma before the conjunction.

Example: Jack is late. + Jack's alarm is broken.

= Jack is late, **because** his alarm is broken.

Add the sentences together with either 'so' or 'because'.

Remember to put a comma before the conjunction.

1. Jamie likes Fortnite. Jamie plays Fortnite for hours.

2. The dog went to the vet. The dog hurt its paw.

3. Robin got 100% on the test. Robin studied hard.

4. It hardly rained this year. The plants died.

5. The pot fell off the table. The baby bumped the table.
