Going To for Predictions and Plans

For predictions based on evidence, or for future plans, use a present form of **be** + **going to** + **verb**.

Remember, the form of be can **be** a contraction.

Affirmative	I'm going a garage sale. You're harvest a lot of vegetables.
Negative	Teresa give a speech tonight. They're to have good weather this year.
Interrogative	Is it going to rain later? Yes, it is. / No, it . Are you going to donate? Yes, we . / No, we aren't.
