

Simple past: Regular verbs

- To form the past form of regular verbs, we add "d" or "ed" to the verb.
Example: want = wanted live = lived
- The ending of the regular verbs in past is pronounced in 3 different ways: /d/, /t/, /id/
- Para formar el pasado de los verbos regulares, agregamos "d" o "ed" al final del verbo.
