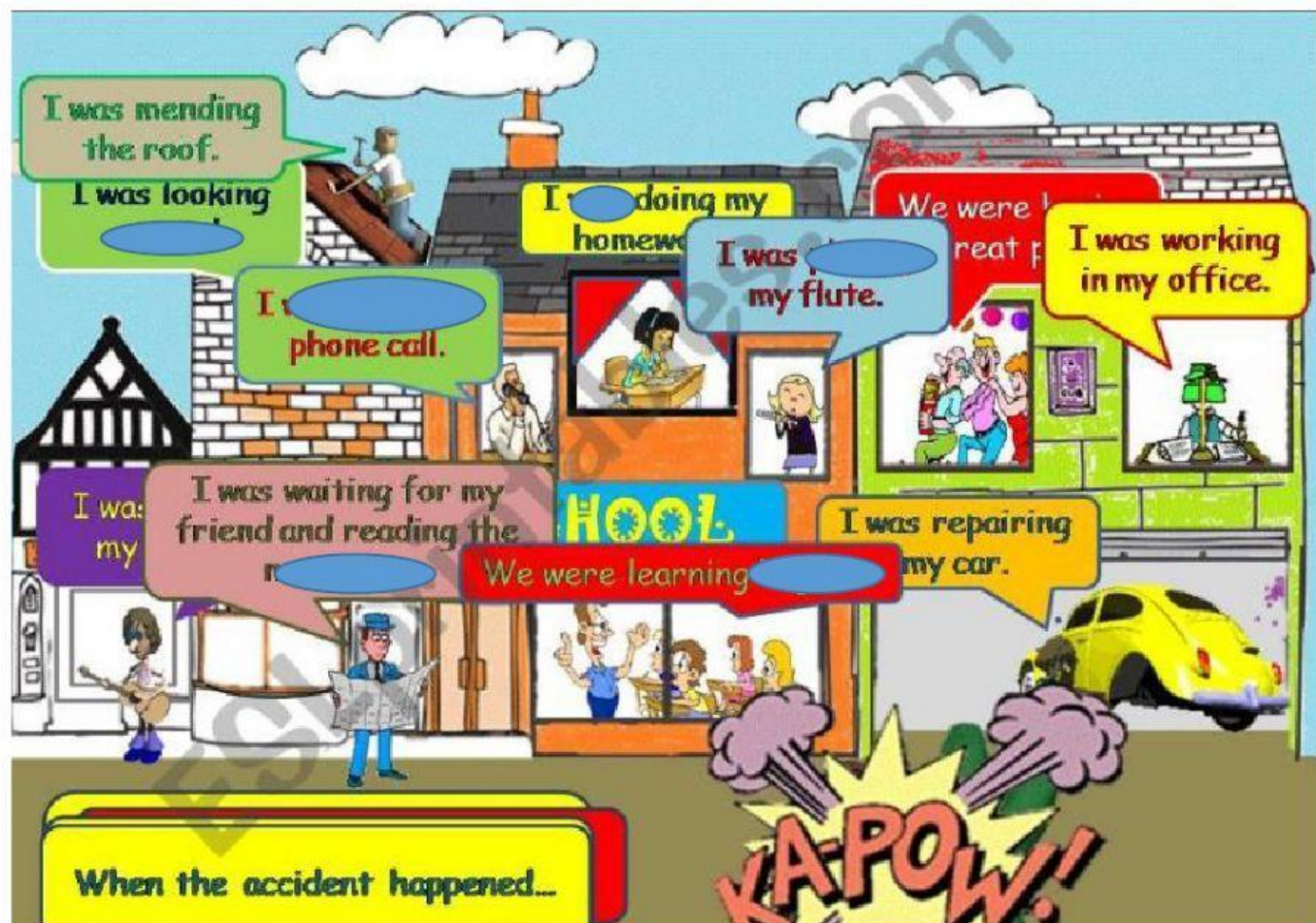

2(they all have Verb-ing)

Affirmative	S + was/were + V-ing She was cooking all the morning.
Negative	S + was/were + not + V-ing She was not sleeping when he came home.
Interrogative	Was/were + S + V-ing Was she sleeping when he came home?
