

The use of **VERB TO BE** and **HAS/HAVE**

I	AM
YOU	ARE
HE/SHE/IT	IS
WE/YOU/THEY	ARE

How to use it:

- ★ The elephant is big. (Used with adjectives. physical description/existence)
- ★ Africa is special. (status/condition)
- ★ I am happy today. (Feelings)
