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1 Abby Smith writes **Ask Abby**, an online advice column that helps teenagers by answering posts about their problems. Abby started her advice column in 2010. At that time, her column was only published in the school magazine where she worked. Today, teens all over the world can ask Abby for her advice.


2 It all started when Abby became a secondary school teacher. At that time, she was only 22 years old. Abby noticed that teens usually shared their problems with her and listened to her advice. Two years later, Abby decided to start her website **Ask Abby**.

3 Abby has learned that teens sometimes prefer to ask for advice in an anonymous way. She says, "Teens usually like to talk about their problems. Sometimes they write, 'I have a problem.' But other times, they prefer to say, 'My friend has this problem...' when

they refer to their own problems.

4 Teens ask for her advice on many different subjects, such as problems in the family, problems at school, eating disorders, bullying, and cyber bullying. Abby confesses that she doesn't always know the answers to every problem. Sometimes she has to ask other experts for help.

5 Nowadays, apart from her job as an online counselor, Abby often visits schools to give advice to teenagers, parents, and teachers. She also hosts a live online weekly radio show about teen problems, and she often makes television appearances that discuss teenage issues.
