'Look! A swimming pool,' says Hare. He goes swimming. Then he sits down next to a tree.

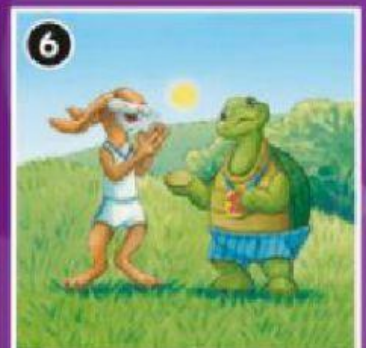
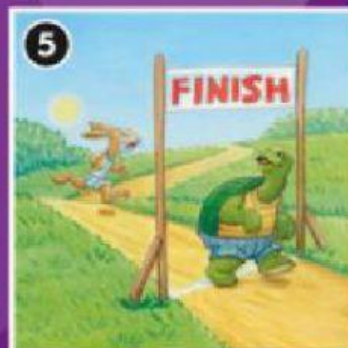
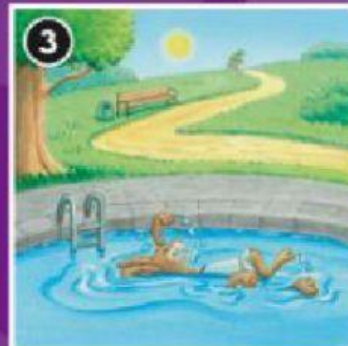
Tortoise walks and walks. Tortoise sees Hare, but Hare doesn't see Tortoise. Hare is asleep.
