The SBT supports homeless children and takes action to get them an education. It promotes learning of crafts, and Mohammad took the opportunity to learn puppetry. Soon people recognized his talent and when he was eighteen, he got a job on a TV show.

But Mohammad hasn't forgotten his origins and he's helped to educate people in the slums of New Delhi. Although he ran away from home, his parents have forgiven him and are proud of their son.
