ADVERBS OF MANNER

They tell us "How an action is done". The adverb of manner usually follows the verb.

SPELLING RULES - ADVERBS

- Adverbs** are normally formed by adding **-LY** to the end of an adjective.

Example: Quick ----- Quickly

Slow ----- slowly

- For adjectives that end in **-L** or **-E**, we simply add **-LY**:

Example: special ----- specially

Nice ----- nicely

- For adjectives that end in **-Y**, we change the **-Y** to an **"I"** and add **-LY**:

Example: crazy ----- crazily

Happy ----- happily

- For adjectives that end in **-BLE**, change it to **-BLY**:

Example: terrible ----- terribly

horrible ----- horribly

- If the adjective ends in **-IC**, we add **-ALLY**:

Example: ironic ----- ironically

enthusiastic ----- enthusiastically

- Some adverbs are irregular:

Example: good ----- well

fast ----- fast

hard ----- hard


