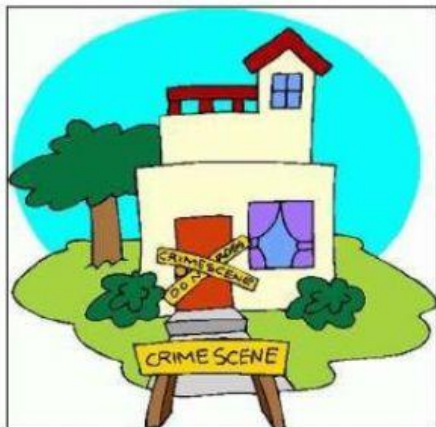


Crimes and Criminals
