

Simple Past – Negative and Interrogative

Recuerda que para formar preguntas y negaciones en el pasado, usamos el auxiliar DID y que el verbo principal, vuelve a su forma infinitiva (o en presente). Aquí te dejo un ejemplo!

- POSITIVE.** Yesterday, I **WENT** to the cinema with Carol.
NEGATIVE. Yesterday, I **DIDN'T GO** to the cinema with Carol.
QUESTION. **DID** you **GO** to the cinema with Carol yesterday?
