### **Third conditional**

**Use:** To talk about imaginary situations in the (1) \_\_\_\_\_ and their results.

#### **Form:**

#### **Positive and negative**

If + past (2) \_\_\_\_\_, + would(n't) have + past (3) \_\_\_\_\_ / perfect...

#### **Questions**

Would + subject + (4) \_\_\_\_\_ + past participle (+ (5) \_\_\_\_\_ + past perfect) ?

*Would you have been late (if you hadn't driven)?*

#### **Short answers**

Yes, I (6) \_\_\_\_\_ / No, I (7) \_\_\_\_\_

#### **Note**

You can also use **should, could** and (8) \_\_\_\_\_ in the result clause.

If the sentence begins with **if**, put a comma before the second clause.

Don't use a comma if the if-clause is the second one.
