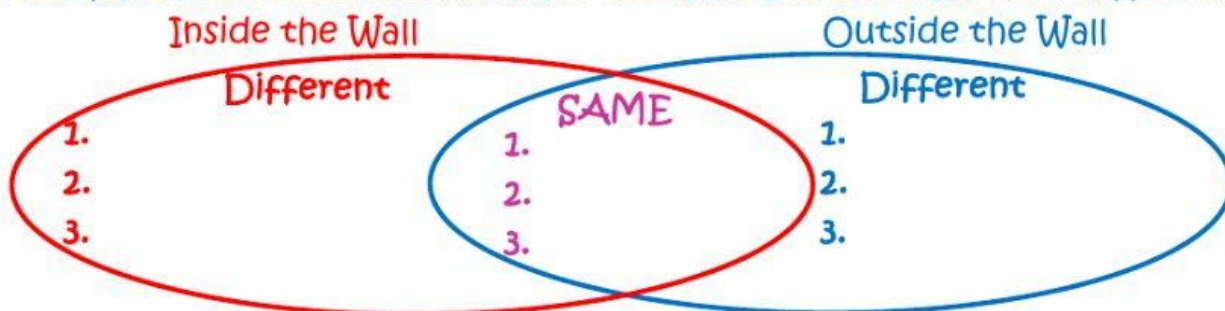
context clue = information you get by looking all around the word
