



Figure Drawing Vocabulary




Symmetry- near or exact matching of left and right sides of a composition




Linear Perspective- parallel lines converge to a point so that objects appear smaller in the distance



Contour Line- an outline and surface ridge of an object




Foreshortening- drawing objects to appear shorter than the original length



Anatomy- the branch of science concerned with the structure of humans, animals and other living organisms




Cast Shadow- shadow on a surface from an object that is very dark




Gesture drawing- quick sketches showing movement of the human body



Searching Lines- lines that move freely and quickly across a surface



Value- the lightness or darkness of a colour



Distort- to twist or turn out of shape when drawing
