Interrogative and short answers

Are oranges **grown** in Spain?

Yes, they **are**. No, they **aren't**.

Wh- questions

Where **are** those cars **made**?

1 We put **is/are** before the subject to make the interrogative form of the passive.

Is information **stored** on the computer?

2 We make short answers with **Yes/No + subject + the correct form of be**.

No, they **aren't**.

Interrogative and short answers

Was this book **written** by Isabel Allende?

Yes, it **was**. No, it **wasn't**.

Wh- questions

When **was** this book **written**?

1 In the interrogative form of the past simple passive, we put **was/were** before the subject.

Were these cars **made** in Japan?

2 We make short answers with **Yes/No + subject + the past simple form of be**.

Yes, it **was**.
