2) Now I would like you to watch my video and then read the following explanation please:

We use "There is/ there are" to talk about something that exists or doesn't exist at somewhere or at any time. It is used to describe what we can see in a place for example: "In my bedroom, there is a big wardrobe" (En mi habitación hay un placard grande)

The choice between the phrases **there is** and **there are** at the beginning of a sentence is determined by the noun that follows it. Use **there is** when the noun is singular ("**There is** a cat"). Use **there are** when the noun is plural ("**There are** two cats").
