| <b>1. The rusty armor</b>             | represents the strange knight's relief that comes from being in peace with himself.                                                                 |
| <b>2. Path of Truth</b>               | represent the knight's allies which give him courage and assistance.                                                                                |
| <b>3. The Woods</b>                   | represents the death of the ego and the rebirth or the true self that gives him strength.                                                           |
| <b>4. Merlin</b>                      | symbolizes the intuition of knowledge, when the knight can unveil his face and see reality more clearly.                                            |
| <b>5. Tears</b>                       | symbolizes the masks we put on in life, which protect us but they also prevent others and especially ourselves from seeing the real us.             |
| <b>6. Animals: Dove and Squirrel</b>  | symbolize the unconscious. By going there, the knight will meet his dark side and destroy the mask that prevents him from knowing his true nature.  |
