We can use the past simple to talk about things **we did in the past**.

The past simple ending is **-ed** for regular verbs:

Play – played watch – watch**ed** want – want**ed**

Irregular verbs have a special form:

Steal – stole break – broke find – found Catch - Caught

For the **negative**, don't change the main verb. We use "**didn't**" instead:

The police **didn't catch** the criminal.
