PAST SIMPLE

Form: we add "ed" to all regular verbs,
Irregular verbs must be learnt by heart.

We use the Past Simple for something in the past which is finished.

- He *played* tennis yesterday.
- The children *went* to the park this morning.

We use "did" to make questions and "didn't" for negatives. The verb stays in the base form.

- *Did* you see Bob yesterday?
- *They didn't* come to the party on Sunday.

PAST CONTINUOUS

Form: **was/were + verb + ing**

The Past Continuous means that at a time in the past we were in the middle of an action.

- *We were playing* tennis at 4 p.m. yesterday.
- *They were eating* when we arrived.

We use: **wasn't/weren't + verb + ing** for negatives:

- *John wasn't reading* a book when we arrived.

We use: **was/were + subject + verb + ing** for questions:

- *Was she making* dinner when you got home?
