

### Time Expressions

- At night
- Today
- Every day / month / year
- Once a day / week / month / year
- Twice a day / week / month / year
- In the morning / afternoon / evening
- Three times a day / week / month / year
- On Monday / Tuesday / Wednesday / etc.
- In July / August / etc.




